Children should bring their PE kits into school every day. There are lots of children without them on PE days at the moment and to avoid this, we suggest that you send them in to school on a Monday morning and then they will be sent home on a Friday afternoon. This ensures that children will have a PE kit in school for any changes to the above timetable.

Just a reminder that PE and swimming are a statutory part of the curriculum and all children have to take part; it is not optional. If your child cannot take part for health or medical reasons, please speak to the class teacher or school office.



Please ensure that correct school PE kit is sent into school. This includes a plain t-shirt (or with logo) in your child's team colour, black, navy or grey shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers. A plain sweatshirt should be provided for colder weather. Hoodies, named clothing, brightly coloured t-shirts/tracksuits or football shirts are not allowed. Earrings and jewellery should not be worn. All clothing needs to be clearly named.



Parking reminder!

Please make sure you park safely when dropping off or collecting your child from school. You should not be parking on the grass verge opposite the school as it is not a safe place to park your car or cross the road with children.
