
We said goodbye to January with our bedtime stories event. Thank you again to those who braved the cold and dark to make it back to school to indulge in hot chocolate and a few good books!














### Parents invited from 2:45pm

## appointments

We would like to politely remind all parents and carers that medical appointments should be made out of school hours. Where this is not possible, please provide the office with evidence of your child's appointment date, time and address to log with our attendance records.

We have noticed an increasing number of children being picked up from school early. In a school where every minute is utilised, this has a significant impact on children's learning time. Also, it is very often the creative subjects that children enjoy that they are missing out on.



Being picked up from school ten minutes early, once a week, equates to losing an entire day of school. Leaving school at 3 o'clock once a week equates to three days of missed learning.

Parents who have an appointment in the afternoon are not permitted to take their child out of school early. In these cases, please try to arrange alternative methods for your child to be collected and notify the school office, or use our wraparound provision that can be booked via Arbor.

Whenever children are being collected or dropped off, only disabled badge holders or taxis are allowed to use the bays at the front of school. Please park safely on the road and walk to the office or gates.
